

Dear Latin Teacher,

You and your students are cordially invited to attend the 20th annual Flint Hill School Certamen, to be held five days before the Ides of January, MMDCCLXIII *ab urbe condit*, ¹ at the Flint Hill Upper School campus.

We will host five levels of competition: Level I, Level I Advanced (for students who are in their second year of a Latin I course), Level II, Level III, and the Upper Level. Each school is allowed to enter **a total of five teams**; however, **there is a limit of two teams per school per level**. Additional students may wish to attend and play on a filler team (if these teams are indeed needed). Moreover, helpers are always appreciated, whether they are parent volunteers, extra players or other members of your club. The registration fee is \$15.00 per team.

There will be the standard three preliminary rounds and one final round of certamen. In the preliminary rounds, each toss-up question will have one *bonus*, whereas in the finals, each toss-up will have two *bon*. Like the past few years, our certamen will be fashioned after NJCL Certamen—the certamen questions will NOT be as difficult as Nationals questions, but the questions will resemble NJCL questions in style and substance, and will include listening comprehension questions.
